COURSE PROVISIONS

1. Abby Road Driving, LLC will provide a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of behind-the-wheel (BTW) instruction, and 4 hours of observation time in a dual controlled automobile, fully insured, covering each student enrolled in the program. Classroom instruction must be a minimum of 3 weeks in length. BTW instruction shall not begin until the student has received a minimum of 4 hours of classroom instruction. BTW instruction must be completed no later than 3 weeks after the classroom instruction has been completed.

REQUIRED LANGUAGE

<u>NOTICE</u> - This provider is required to be certified by the Secretary of State. Completion of driver education instruction does not guarantee qualification for a driver license.

TERMS

- 1. The student must be at least 14 years/8 months of age by the first scheduled day of class (verification by birth certificate required).
- 2. The parent or guardian agrees to pay the amount of \$425.00 by cash or check, credit cards are not accepted, which needs to be paid in full by the following date: The First Day of Class. The full amount is required before a certificate of completion is issued. There is a \$35.00 charge for all returned checks.
- 3. Requirements to pass the course: Attend a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction, complete all homework assignments, passing score of 80% on each classroom quiz, complete student workbook, classroom participation is required for all assigned articles.
- 4. The required score to pass the STATE TEST is 70%. Students may retake the test up to two additional times provided that 24 hours has elapsed between each retake. Failing the state test after three times constitutes failure of segment 1.
- 5. The cost of materials and supplies for the class are included in tuition.
- 6. In the event of a driving appointment cancellation, a cancellation fee of \$50.00 will be charged if 24 hour advance notice is not given to Office Personal.
- 7. In case of a student's absence or emergency the school's policy is: The state requires a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction, any missed days must be made up before a certificate of completion will be issued. Make-up day policy is as follows: Any missed classes will be scheduled during the next regularly scheduled class at no additional charge. \$100.00 will be charged if a student wishes to schedule a make-up date immediately after the course. If the student fails to attend a scheduled make-up date, the \$100.00 will be forfeited.
- 8. Tuition and any additional fees must be paid before a certificate of completion will be issued.

REFUND POLICY

- 1. If for any reason you decide to withdraw from the course before its completion, your refund will be based on the following:
 - a. If withdrawal is after any driving has taken place, no refund will be given.
 - b. During the first two classes, if no behind the wheel lessons were taken, 25% of the total tuition is refunded.
 - c. Withdrawal after the second class, no refund will be issued.

Textbooks: Provided for you. If the book is not returned, or it is returned in poor condition, there is a \$30.00 book fee, which must be paid before your certificate will be issued.

<u>Drive Times:</u> Students must show up, on time, for every scheduled driving time.

Classroom Attendance Requirements: Students may not miss any classroom time.
